While ponies may be approved for temporary or tentative registration, or Breeding Stock papers with a QPA affiliate, only ponies that meet the standards of QPA are authorized to receive a special seal on affiliate registration papers. Inspection helps QPA assure pony owners, and our affiliate registries, the applicant ponies are within the guidelines established for participation in competitions, QPA points and QPA awards programs. Ponies receiving the QPA authorized seal on their papers, without a physical inspection, are subject to future inspection at any time QPA eligibility is properly brought forth to QPA. Adverse findings or owner refusal to allow inspection will cause the seal on the pony's registration papers to become null and void, all QPA points and or QPA titles earned revoked, a designation of "QPA Disqualified" on the ponies records, and the affiliate registry shall be notified of the disqualification status from all future QPA points and awards programs.
